

Master Class List

1. RA OPEN – Open to any valid RA card holder.
2. RA LIMITED OPEN—Open to valid RA card holders who have earned less than \$10,000 lifetime earnings.
3. RA NON PRO—Open to valid RA Non Pro card holders.
4. RA INTERMEDIATE NON PRO—Open to valid RA Non Pro card holders who have earned less than \$10,000 life time earnings.
5. RA LIMITED NON PRO—Open to valid RA Non Pro card holders who have earned less than \$2500 lifetime earnings.
6. RA ROOKIE—Open to valid RA Non Pro card holders who have earned less than \$500 lifetime earnings. Rider must show one handed. Non Pro horse ownership rules do not apply.
7. RA RANCH REINER—Open to valid RA Non Pro card holders who have earned less than \$250 lifetime earnings. Rider may show one or two handed in any legal bit.
8. RA GREEN REINER—Open to valid RA Non Pro card holders with \$0 lifetime earnings. Rider may show one or two handed in any legal bit.
9. RA YOUTH 13 & UNDER—Open to valid RA Non Pro card holders who are age 13 or under on January 1st of the current year.
10. RA YOUTH 14-18—Open to valid RA Non Pro card holders who are age 14 to 18 on January 1st of the current year.
11. RA BEGINNER YOUTH 13 & UNDER –Open to valid RA Non Pro card holders who are age 13 or under on January 1st of the current year with \$0 lifetime earnings. Rider may show one or two handed in a full bridle. Non Pro horse ownership rules do not apply.
12. RA BEGINNER YOUTH 14 – 18 – Open to valid RA Non Pro card holders who are age 14 – 18 on January 1st of the current year with \$0 lifetime earnings. Rider may show one or two handed in a full bridle. Non Pro horse ownership rules do not apply.
13. RA SHORT STIRRUP—Open to valid RA Non Pro card holders who are age 10 and under as of January 1st of current year. Non pro horse ownership rules do not apply. Rider may show one or two handed at the walk or trot. New modified pattern 11.
14. RA SENIOR NON PRO—Open to valid RA Non Pro card holders 45 years or older as of January 1st of the current year.
15. RA BEGINNER HORSE OPEN —Open to horses that have earned less than \$200 in lifetime earnings as of January 1st. Rider must be a valid RA card holder. Rider may show one or two handed in a full bridle.
16. RA BEGINNER HORSE NON PRO—Open to horses that have earned less than \$200 in lifetime earnings as of January 1st, but limited to valid RA Non Pro card holders. Rider may show one or two handed in a full bridle.
