General Rules

1. All reining classes will be judged according to the National Reining Horse Association 2010 Handbook. Earnings will be lifetime earnings (LTE), meaning all monies earned in any reining event; records are available at www.equistat.com.
2. Entries must be postmarked no later than July 23, 2010. Entries may NOT be e-mailed. Late entries will be assessed at \$15.00 per class or 30% for Open Futurity and Non Pro classes. There will be no exceptions. Returned cheques will not be considered timely payment and the penalty as well as a \$20.00 NSF charge will apply. There will be no refunds, but substitutions may be made upon notification to the Show Secretary with a vet certificate.
3. Payouts will be made according to the 2010 NRHA Handbook Payback Schedule A. The show committee will retain 30% of all entry fees except youth classes.
4. Riders in the Ranch class are not required to own their horses; no ownership rules apply.
5. For horses entered in the Open Futurity class, a photocopy of the horse's competition license and/or registration papers must accompany the entry. Grade horses entered in age specific classes must supply a veterinarian's certificate providing proof of the horse's age.
6. The original premise of this show was to host a "no complaining" reining. No horse shall be abused or mistreated, and no un-sportsman like conduct towards the judges, show committee, or other participants. You could try complaining to Jaime or Jessica, but it probably won't get you anywhere.
7. Entries should be made in Canadian funds; for U.S. entries, an "at par" exchange rate will be used.
8. There is no limit on the number of horses shown by one rider. Class numbers permitting, riders will be allotted three draws between horses if riding multiple entries.
9. Post entries will be accepted until 2 hours prior to a class starting. Draws for post entries will be added at the beginning of the regular drawn order (except in the case of an exhibitor with multiple horses). A late fee of \$15.00 per class will be charged or 30% for Open Futurity and Non Pro classes.
10. Stalls and arena will be available at Thursday, August 12. Bedding will be provided for stalls. Please note, stalls cannot be reserved by phone. Tack and feed stalls are permitted.
11. Eligible equipment must be used as stated in the 2010 NRHA Rule Book, unless the class rules otherwise.
12. Paid warm-ups will be slotted on a first come first serve basis, for the duration of five minutes, and must be paid in full with entries prior to horses being allowed in the show arena.
13. The show committee retains full discretion and reserves the right to make adjustments to the event. In the event of a cancellation, all money will be refunded.
14. Silver Slate Arena, the show committee and volunteers are not responsible for losses, damages or injuries. All participants must sign a waiver before they will be eligible to show.
